CELL PHONES



Cell phone use is prohibited during class time. Students can use cell phones during the lunch break. The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPA) requires that student privacy is protected at all times. Pictures can not be taken of other students without their permission.

Staff do not communicate with parents via a student's cell phone. All communication with staff is to be done through the school phone.

BIKES, SKATEBOARDS & SCOOTERS

Bikes must be walked upon arrival at school and parked in the bike racks. Bike locks are recommended. Students are not permitted to be around the bike rack area during the school day. Heritage Park cannot be responsible for bikes brought to school.

We recommend that skateboards & scooters be left at home. If you must bring them to school, contact the school administration about storage in the office.





LOCKERS

All École Heritage Park Middle School students may have access to a school locker. The lockers are the property of the school and are “rented” to students for the school year. Assigned lockers and school locks must not be traded or changed. Moving lockers could forfeit the use of a school locker. Keep your locker combination confidential and DO NOT share your combination with anyone. Personal locks are NOT allowed on lockers and will be cut off if found. The school administration can access any locker at any time if they deem it necessary.
