Dress For Success

Closed Campus

École Heritage Park Middle School is a closed campus.

- Students stay on campus all day.
- Any visitors to the school must check in at the office.
- Administration will call the student to the office after the check-in procedure.



Boundaries

Personal Electronic Devices



- Phones, earbuds, and headphones must be secured away upon entering the learning space.
- Pictures cannot be taken of other students without their permission as per the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPA)
- *Cell Phones are not to be taken into the hallways/washrooms during instructional time*
- Social Media sites such as Facebook, AskFM, Instagram, SnapChat, etc. are not to be accessed during instructional time.
- Students use the office phone to contact parents during instructional time.
- All parent communication with staff is done through the school phone.

- Students are not permitted to be around the bike rack area during the school day.
- Heritage Park cannot be responsible for bikes brought to school.

We recommend that skateboards & scooters be left at home.

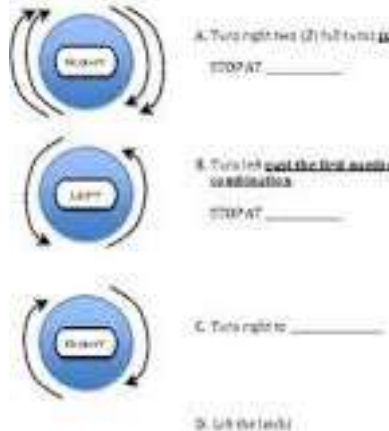

HOW TO OPEN YOUR LOCKER



- Lockers are the property of the school and are “rented” to students
- Lockers and locks must not be traded or changed
- Keep your locker combination confidential and **DO NOT** share your combination with anyone
- Personal locks are **NOT** allowed on lockers and will be *cut off* if found
- Administration can access lockers at any time if they deem it necessary

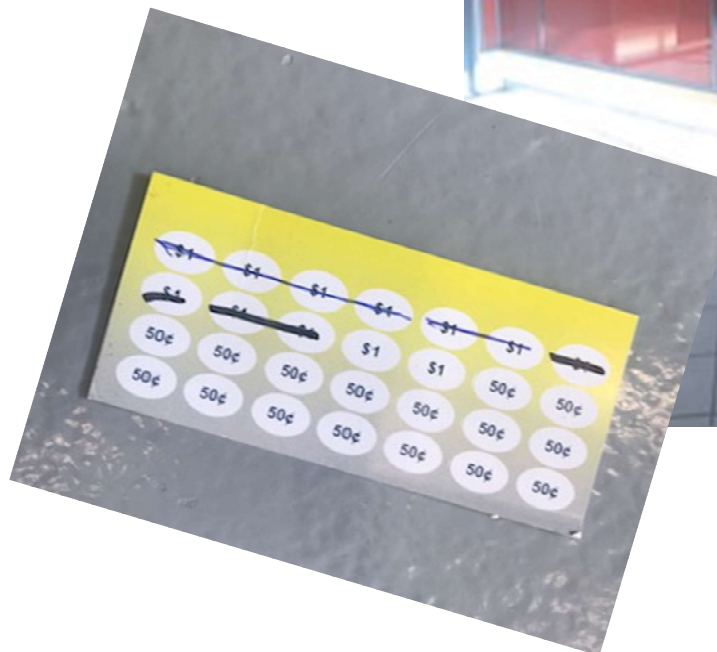
